Hover over the **My Features** tab and select **E-lists** from the dropdown menu. 4: Manage Your Listservs: • Toggle your **Subscribed Status** and **Email Delivery** settings for each Listserv.

• Change the Per Page dropdown to 10 to view all available Listservs on one page. You can subscribe, or opt in, to any and all lists that apply to you.
