## Scholarships

The College of Agricultural and Life Sciences awarded nearly \$1 million in scholarships to current and incoming students for the 2016-17 year. More than half of our students receive scholarships. Combined with external scholarships and waivers, our students receive more than \$3.5 million in support each year.
