## Scholarships

The College of Agricultural and Life Sciences awarded nearly **\$1 million** in scholarships to current and incoming students for the 2016-17 year.

**More than half** of our students receive scholarships. Combined with external scholarships and waivers, our students receive more than **\$3.5 million** in support each year.

- **100% job placement** for the UI/WSU School of Food Science.
- **100% job placement** for Agricultural and Extension Education graduates.
- **85%** of Animal and Veterinary Science graduates have a job at graduation.
