- ➤ A completed online application form
- > \$60 application fee
- ➤ ACT or SAT scores (official, sent directly from testing agency)

OSU ACT code: 3312 OSU SAT code: 1009

- > Official high school transcripts
- Transfer students will need to send all official college transcripts (transfer applicants with 30 semester credit hours or 45 quarter credit hours do not need to send high school transcripts)
- Home-schooled and non-Ohio residents are reviewed on an individual and competitive basis. ACT, SAT or GED scores are needed for review before a decision is determined
